IMPROVE YOUR VIEW

A utility box in your yard is not its most

ornamental feature. Plantings can soften and conceal these boxes, but be sure to think about access and safety first. This plan leaves 10 feet of clear space in front of the access doors, and 3 feet of clear space on the other sides. But check with your local utility company before you start to plant, as individual utility companies have different access requirements. Although we've used mulch directly around this electrical box, some companies also allow low-growing perennials, annuals or ground covers — just choose something that won't be harmed if it gets stepped on. Repeat plants from this plan elsewhere in your yard to draw your eye away from the utility box and toward your beautiful plantings.

 Yellow-striped leaf blades, white plumes in late
 summer to fall; 5 to 8 ft. tall, 2 to 6 ft. wide; cold-hardy
 in USDA zones 5 to 9; heat-tolerant in AHS zones 9 to 1
- D Catmint Nepeta racemosa 'Walker's Low' (7) Purple flowers from early to late summer; 18 to 36 in. tall and wide; cold-hardy in USDA zones 3 to 9; heat-tolerant in AHS zones 9 to 1
- E Daylily Hemerocallis 'Rosy Returns' (39)

 Slightly fragrant pink blooms from early to late summer; 15 in. tall, 12 to 18 in. wide; cold-hardy in USDA zones 3 to 9; heat-tolerant in AHS zones 9 to 1
- F Peegee hydrangea Hydrangea paniculata
 'Grandiflora' (1)
 White flowers in mid- to late summer: 10 to 25

White flowers in mid- to late summer; 10 to 25 ft. tall, 8 to 16 ft. wide; cold-hardy in USDA zones 3 to 9; heat-tolerant in AHS zones 9 to 1
