

# GARDENIA Gardenia augusta

- Light: Full sun
- Temperature: 60 to 75 degrees
- Care: Keep soil moist and mist occasionally to keep humidity high. Feed monthly with plant food for acid-lovers. Move outside to shade when nighttime temps remain above 60 degrees.





#### GERBERA DAISY Gerbera jamesonii

- Light: Bright light
- Temperature: 55 to 70 degrees
- Care: Plant outside in full sun when nighttime temperatures remain above 55 degrees. Keep moist. Use a water-soluble fertilizer monthly while in flower.

# CINERARIA Persicallis xhybrida

- Light: Bright light
- **Temperature:** Flowers best at 45 to 60 degrees, but will tolerate higher temperatures.
- Care: Watch for bugs. Keep soil moist. No need to fertilize.
  Compost when finished flowering.

# KALANCHOE Kalanchoe blossfeldiana


- Light: Prefers bright light, tolerrates lower light when flowering.
- Temperature: 50 to 70 degrees
- Care: Keep soil moist and leaves dry to prevent fungal problems. No need to feed.
  Compost when finished flowering.





#### AZALEA Rhododendron indica

- Light: Bright light
- **Temperature:** Flowers best at 50 to 60 degrees, but will tolerate higher temperatures.
- Care: After flowers fade, deadhead and trim plant up and repot every couple of years. Keep humidity up by misting; keep soil moist. No need to feed when flowering. After it blooms, feed monthly with water-soluble, acid-lover's fertilizer.



#### OXALIS Oxalis spp.

- Light: Bright to medium light
- Temperature: Stays freshest looking at 45 to 60 degrees, but will tolerate higher temperatures.
- Care: After flowers fade, withhold water and set in a dry, dark spot. Resume watering in 2 to 3 months and move back to bright light. Let soil dry out between waterings. Fertilize monthly while flowering.

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
